## Why We Belong

For many members, the bi-monthly *Star* magazine provides excellent value for the annual \$49 dues. Information about new Mercedes models, articles on old models, maintenance tips, solutions for common technical problems, racing news, tours through Germany and elsewhere, buyers' guides to earlier model series, classified ads from parts and service suppliers, and glorious photos provide something for everyone's interest.

The Mercedes-Benz Club of America website at [www.mbca.org](http://www.mbca.org) has a wealth of information for members, including how to save \$1,000 on a new Mercedes, access to forums containing specialized technical, maintenance and repair information, news about all sections, discounts for members, and much more. Spend some time on the site.

The monthly SFBA Section newsletter gives information on local activities and events—what is planned, how to register, and reports of completed events, including photos of attendees. Also the newsletter includes local commercial and classified ads, including discount offers. A directory of the section's leadership gives the names and contact information for the dozen volunteers that guide the section.

Local section events are usually planned for the next year at a Board of Directors Meeting in October or November—open to all members. Do you have an idea for a great event? Bring it to the Planning Meeting. This is your chance to make it happen.

Some members attend many of the local events. Others are attracted to the technical events. Some watch for and attend events in their vicinity, and others attend events that gain entrance to unique auto collections, such as the recent Blackhawk Museum visit.

There is usually one overnight scenic driving event each year, perhaps a rally, with interesting stops along the way at wineries, cheese makers, and other attractions and a chance to join those on the tour for dinner. First Sunday Drives are open to all Mercedes owners, not just club members. The routes change monthly, using old scenic byways, driving off from the starting point at 10:00 a.m. and ending at a place where a good lunch can be had. 
