### AVIATION DAY AT UAL'S SFO-MOC

Have you ever wanted to see an airliner cockpit up close, or what an airliner looks like taken apart for one of its many required inspections, or what the maintenance facility for a major airline looks like? If so, then you can satisfy your curiosity by taking this **tour of the United Airlines Maintenance Operation Center at San Francisco Airport (SFO-MOC)**.

Depending on which aircraft are being worked on, you'll be able to view Boeing 777, 747, 767, 757 or Airbus 320 undergoing maintenance. A cockpit visit and perhaps a walk around under the aircraft will be included. One of the guides will be club member Ernie Ordasi, who organized this event.

Space is limited, so please make your reservations as soon as possible (form on page 9). Deadline is January 2, 2012. The guided tour will take approximately one and a half hours. You must wear closed-toe, flat shoes for safety reasons. Be prepared to walk about a mile and climb stairs. Bring your camera. Bring your picture ID. You will be issued a badge (you are entering the airport's security zone).

Plan to arrive at 9:30 a.m. The tour start time is 9:45 a.m. If this tour fills up, we may be able to add a later tour that day. A detailed map and parking directions will be sent to you once your reservation has been accepted. There is a nominal charge of \$5 per person. ### ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS AND YOUR MERCEDES-BENZ

They will also demonstrate the brand new **Hunter Smart Weight Tire Balancing System** and provide a tire balancing for one member's car. Tires and rims are touched by nylon or plastic parts, some of which roll along the rim to avoid any sliding contact or risk of scratching
